

## CARBON REDUCTION PLAN GUIDANCE

# **Notes for Completion**

Where an In-Scope Organisation has determined that the measure applies to the procurement, suppliers wishing to bid for that contract are required at the selection stage to submit a Carbon Reduction Plan which details their organisational carbon footprint and confirms their commitment to achieving Net Zero by 2050.

Carbon Reduction Plans are to be completed by the bidding supplier<sup>1</sup> and must meet the reporting requirements set out in supporting guidance, and include the supplier's current carbon footprint and its commitment to reducing emissions to achieve Net Zero emissions by 2050.

The CRP should be specific to the bidding entity, or, provided certain criteria are met, may cover the bidding entity and its parent organisation. In order to ensure the CRP remains relevant, a Carbon Reduction Plan covering the bidding entity and its parent organisation is only permissible where the detailed requirements of the CRP are met in full, as set out in the Technical Standard<sup>2</sup> and Guidance<sup>3</sup>, and all of the following criteria are met:

- The bidding entity is wholly owned by the parent;
- The commitment to achieving net zero by 2050 for UK operations is set out in the CRP for the parent and is supported and adopted by the bidding entity, demonstrated by the inclusion in the CRP of a statement that this will apply to the bidding entity;
- The environmental measures set out are stated to be able to be applied by the bidding entity when performing the relevant contract; and
- The CRP is published on the bidding entity's website.

Bidding entities must take steps to ensure they have their own CRP as soon as reasonably practicable and should note that the ability to rely on a parent organisation's Carbon Reduction Plan may only be a temporary measure under this selection criterion.

The Carbon Reduction Plan should be updated regularly (at least annually) and published and clearly signposted on the supplier's UK website. It should be approved by a director (or equivalent senior leadership) within the supplier's organisation to demonstrate a clear commitment to emissions reduction at the highest level. Suppliers may wish to adopt the key objectives of the Carbon Reduction Plan within their strategic plans.



# **Emissions reduction targets**

Ewood Foods Ltd have set an ambitious target to reduce our Scope 1 & 2 emissions by at least 25% by 2030. This decrease will see our Scope 1 and 2 emissions drop from **361.65 tCO2e** to **271.24 tCO2e** by 2030.

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

## **Carbon Reduction Projects**

The 2023 data forms the baseline for the Carbon Reduction plans for Ewood Foods Ltd.

The following environmental management measures and projects would be considered as part of the steps to achieve our carbon reduction goals:

- Review the current thermostat settings and look to turn them down at least one degree Celsius and educate staff.
- Explore the opportunity for diesel substitution with HVO (Hydrogenated Vegetable Oil).
- Raise energy awareness among warehouse and butchery department staff and appoint "Energy Champions", staff members responsible for turning off lights and equipment when not in use and making sure that heating and hot water are set at the right temperature.
- Explore technologies such as Power Factor Correction, Voltage Optimisation and Energy Management to reduce energy consumption
- Purchase energy from renewable sources
- Carry out a strategic waste review, which would identify opportunities for further recycling.
- Develop a companywide Sustainable Procurement Policy

# **Declaration and Sign Off**

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
